Crates COA \#5 and \#7 should be loaded through the side door of the transport van up near the driver's area. Crates COA \#2, \#3, \& \#4 should be loaded next, via the rear door. Crate COA \#6 should be loaded next, placed flat on top of crate COA \#2, \#3, \& \#4. Crate COA \#2 should be loaded through the rear door and placed along the driver's side. The Four-wheel Dollies should be packed loosely near or just in front of crate COA \#2, as they're one of the last items to be loaded and the first things needs at the next venue. The Blanket Wrapped Media Kiosk should always be laid out on the floor of the transport van, at the rear of the vehicle, and should be loaded last. The space required for the pack as described is 53 " $\mathbf{w} \mathbf{X}$ $137^{\prime \prime}$ long total. Essentially the back of an extended length cargo van.
